Agenda items discussed:

1. Proposed FUTSAL tournament:

the deadline for entries will be extended by 2 weeks (to Friday 2nd June 2017). The tournament will probably be a 1 day event (Friday 16th June 2017) and depending on entries the tournament may be divided into 2 sections: Junior tournament (U14 and U15 combined) and a Senior tournament (U16 and open combined). Mr Lewis Donnelly will be the overall organiser. He would enter All Stars teams of boys in schools not involved in the tournament.

2. Pre-season festivals (Wednesday 5 July 2017)

This is a 1 day event and would start at 8:30am. The KZN selectors and coaches would be present to start having an early look at the talent available.

The nomination form for the appointment of KZN coaches would go shortly so appointments can be in place before the season starts.

3. Referees shirts:

It was proposed that all referees officiating at our festivals/tournaments be given a referee shirt to wear with Build-it (our sponsor) logo on it.

4. Mr Reagan Stuart has been requested to convene a team of selectors to do the KZN team selections this year. His selectors need to try to get to all festivals/tournaments/trials to make the selection process as comprehensive as possible.

5. KZN trials process:

Schools will be required to submit their nominations for the 1st round of trials in writing, prior to the day of the trials. These nominations would go to the Regional Co-ordinator at each trials venue in their region.

6. Winter games selection process:

Dr Cowie would send the info he had received from the Education Department regarding trials dates etc. to all schools.

7. End of year tour: Gauteng – U/14 and U/16 KZN teams

Stef Crasso will be asked to check the dates of the inter-club tournament which we have been played in, in the past. Failing this, Steve Bezuidenhout was tasked to investigate our Association jointly running a tournament in Gauteng with one of the big clubs as our tour for the u/14 and u/16 teams. An 'A' team with
